

Perspectives...
who is right
and who is
wrong?



A simple yet powerful message about perspective and point of view.

Originally used to illustrate an announcement for a course on developing intercultural competence, and very simply shows the possibility for people having different interpretations of the same thing depending on each person's perspective.

It is clear that both perceptions are right; neither is wrong.

It's easy to see how each character could adapt to see the other's point of view, by standing side by side. Adaptation in real life can be more complicated, but the simplicity of the cartoon offers a hopeful message that creating understanding of the other person's perception or point of view is possible.

Although the original cartoon was aimed at developing intercultural competence, the cartoon offers value for organisations faced with ongoing changes, transformation or Continuous Improvement programmes. Exploring and understanding perspectives goes a long way to gaining buy in and connection with people's point of view.
